Graduate students in all disciplines are welcome to apply, we encourage social sciences and humanities to apply. Prior Chicana/o Studies coursework preferred, but not required. Previous TA experience not required.

Responsibilities of a TA in Chicana/o Studies courses may include, but are not limited to: (1) attending all class lectures; (2) preparing and leading discussion section; (3) grading exams, essays, and student journals; (4) keeping a grade book; (5) monitoring student attendance; (6) participating in meetings with the professor and other TA's.

TA Requirements

- Registered and enrolled as a UCLA graduate student
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 units and be in good academic standing
- Hold a cumulative GPA of 3.0 at the time of appointment
- No incompletes at the time of appointment
- NOT have a 50% appointment at the time of appointment
- Must read all reading assignments for course assigned
